Community Mediation Services

A non-profit organization committed to respectfully managing and resolving conflict, Community Mediation Services utilizes trained volunteers to mediate and resolve disputes and make decisions outside of the courts.

Mediation can effectively be used to resolve conflicts in a manner that is both cost effective and agreeable to the parties involved. Pre-filing mediation is a resource for tenants and landlords to avoid or supplement court actions. More information about pre-filing mediation and ways to successfully address conflicts will be presented at the meeting.


